Anarchism and the Advent of Paris Dada sheds new light on Paris Dada's role in developing the anarchist and individualist philosophies that helped shape the cultural dialogue in France following the First World War drawing on such surviving documentation as correspondence criticism periodicals pamphlets and manifestoes this book argues that contrary to received wisdom Dada was driven by a vision of social change through radical cultural upheaval the first book length study to interrogate the Paris Dadaists complex and often contested position in the postwar groundswell of anarcho individualism anarchism and the advent of Paris Dada offers an unprecedented analysis of Paris Dada literature and art in relation to anarchism and also revives a variety of little known anarcho individualist texts and periodicals in doing so it reveals the general ideological diversity of the postwar French avant garde and identifies its anarchist concerns in addition it challenges the accepted paradigm that postwar cultural politics were monolithically nationalist by positioning Paris Dada in its anarchist context this volume addresses a long ignored lacuna in Dada scholarship and more broadly takes its place alongside the numerous studies that over the past two decades have problematized the politics of modern art literature and culture

This collection of critical essays celebrates the subversive and challenging creativity of the Dada movement born in pacifist Zurich in

1916 in violent reaction to the first world war it examines the collective and individual activities that took place under the name of dada in zurich cologne berlin paris new york and barcelona and explores the various creative forms employed including text collage photomontage objects dance performance and film the authors suggest new ways of understanding the work of the most famous dadaists while also casting light on the contribution of hitherto neglected figures far from attempting to reduce dada to a homogeneous movement or to define a unifying principle beneath and beyond the multiple directions taken by dadaists this collection aims to respect the diversity and heterogeneity of the movement s collective activities as well as the specificity of its individual actors

the first full study of the role of little magazines and their contribution to the making of artistic modernism and the avant garde across europe this volume is a major scholarly achievement of immense value to those interested in material culture of the twentieth century

the american artist man ray was one of the most influential figures of the historical avant garde contributing significantly to the development of both dadaism and surrealism whilst his pioneering work in photography assured him international acclaim his activity in other areas notably film is to this day both unknown and undervalued during the 1920s man ray made four short experimental films and collaborated on a host of other projects with people such as marcel duchamp fernand léger rené clair and hans richter these works along with a series of cinematic essays and home movies made during the 1920s and 1930s represent the most important contribution to the development of an alternative mode of filmmaking in the early twentieth century this book explores man ray s cinematic interactions from the perspective of his interdisciplinary artistic sensibility creating links between film photography painting poetry music architecture dance and sculpture by exposing his preoccupation with form and his ambiguous relationship with the politics and aesthetics of the dada and surrealist movements the author paints an intimate and complex portrait of man ray the filmmaker

dada this onomatopoeia suggesting a child s babbling started one of the most important mutations in the history of art but what is dada born of the first world war dada is a movement bringing together both artists and writers from zurich in 1916 it spread rapidly to new york berlin hanover cologne and finally to paris where it died in 1924 because of the diversity of its creations the dada movement is not an ism of the art world there is no dada style although a single spirit does govern the works of this movement which is at once anti conformist anti bourgeois and above all anti artistic

this study of six early twentieth century periodicals serves to refine the traditional image of the inter war journal as the pre eminent vehicle of artistic and intellectual renewal every periodical has its own history but general themes are clearly identified traces emerge of a common commitment to the internationalisation of the arts and we find early and unexpected discussion of freud chaplin and joyce in brussels and berlin jazz in vienna and brussels ezra pound in the netherlands and belgium in contrast to this internationalisation are the ambitions of the various editors to play a significant role in their national cultures this tension between national and international influences was in the first instance stimulating and innovative later as a result of political and socio economic developments the newly achieved openness and exchange were gradually diminished and finally disappeared as did the periodicals themselves

jody blake demonstrates in this book that although the impact of african american music and dance in france was constant from 1900 to 1930 it was not unchanging this was due in part to the stylistic development and diversity of african american music and dance from the prewar cakewalk and ragtime to the postwar charleston and jazz successive groups of modernists beginning with the matisse and picasso circle in the 1900s and concluding with the surrealists and purists in the 1920s constructed different versions of la musique and la danse negre manifested in creative and critical works these responses to african american music and dance reflected the modernists varying artistic agendas and historical climates
